800: COLLECTION

801: Collection (Any group of five or more closely related models. Entries in this category can be the work of an individual or a group.)

802: Triathlon (Three models from different major categories, all built by the same modeler. Previous winners in solo categories are eligible in this category only.)

803: Miniature Army (Any group of five or more closely related gaming miniatures. Judging is based on painting skill and the size of the army.)
